

About WAIS:

The Wide Area Interoperability System (WAIS) takes advantage of VoIP to connect dispersed communications efforts via an existing infrastructure, such as a Local Area Network (LAN), Wide Area Network (WAN) or the Internet. By connecting interoperability systems to a LAN/WAN, radio communications can be extended over a wide geographic area while using existing radios and frequencies of all public safety organizations involved, including virtually any combination of local, state and national agencies.

From any point on a network, users may configure, control and monitor any interconnected, on-site interoperability systems. Where the radio resources are located is immaterial. Users can simply click on separate radio systems on a monitor to connect them for direct and efficient communications.
